The number of crimes in the Internet has been increasing. Someone wrongly obtains and uses another person's personal data, such as name, date of , or driver's license number, as well as credit card, bank account, and phone numbers. It involves deception<sup>1</sup>, typically with the  of making money. Identity thieves use a variety of  to gain access to others' personal information and steal their identity.

In recent years, the Internet has become an appealing place for criminals to obtain identifying data, such as passwords or even banking information. In their haste to  the exciting features of the Internet, many people respond to "Spam mail"<sup>2</sup> that promises them some benefit but  identifying data, without realizing that in many cases, the requester has no intention of  his promise.

You should never provide your personal information in response to a request you did not ask for over the Internet. E-mail and Internet pages created by "phishers"<sup>3</sup> may look exactly like the real thing. They may even have a fake icon<sup>4</sup> that ordinarily is used to prove it is a secure site. It is always safe to go to the company's Website by typing in the site address directly or using a page you have previously bookmarked,  of a link provided in the e-mail.

Another way of being  from identity thieves is to install safety programs and keep your anti-virus<sup>5</sup> software up-to-date. You should report any crimes to the police immediately after they are detected.
