In a famous experiment, people are asked to watch a video and count the number of times that basketballs are passed from one person to another. Half of the viewers do not see a gorilla that appears and walks slowly across the screen. Although their eyes see the gorilla and their brains the image, the viewers do not have any memory of the gorilla. Researchers believe the brain ignores the gorilla because it is not expected to be seen and its appearance is not helpful in completing the basketball-counting task.

A group of scientists who study the brain understands sounds wondered if the brain could also ignore obvious sounds that are not expected to be heard and not helpful in completing a task. To prepare for their experiment, they recorded two conversations. In one, two men talk with each other as they prepare food for a party. In the other conversation, two women talk as they wrap gifts for the same party. The test subjects were told to follow either the men's conversation or the women's. They wore headphones and listened to the conversations, which were played at the same time. In the middle of the conversations a different, male voice said, "I'm a gorilla" sixteen times.

After listening to the conversations, the volunteers answered questions about the one they had followed. When asked if they heard any strange statements, almost none of those who followed the conversation heard the phrase "I'm a gorilla." As for those who followed the conversations, two out of three heard the phrase. Since this group paid attention to the male voices, it is not surprising that they were more likely to hear the gorilla statement. Even so, the study results add to the evidence that concentrating on a task may us to miss strange things that are happening around us.

Today, the phrase ‘the pirates of the Caribbean’¹ is widely known because of the film series, *Pirates of the Caribbean*, Disney theme park attractions of the same name, and so on. While an act of ‘piracy’, which means attacking and robbing ships of their goods at sea, dates back several thousand, today’s image of piracy comes from the sea gangs of the Caribbean, called ‘pirates’, in the late 16th and early 17th centuries. [A] Perhaps the most famous pirate was Francis Drake. He came from England. Interestingly, this Caribbean pirate is the man who may have laid the foundations of the British Empire and modern British society. Francis Drake may be more important than the Queen of England regarding the development of technology and globalization.

In the late 16th century, after Columbus arrived in the Americas², the Caribbean Sea was important for European countries, particularly Spain and Portugal, the most powerful nations in Europe with colonies across the world. Ships with traders and cargoes sailed from Europe in order to trade with the colonies in the Americas. [B] However, these ships were often attacked by pirate ships from England. At the time, England than it is today. Queen Elizabeth I of England had granted permission and funded pirate ships to catch the Spanish and Portuguese ships. Francis Drake received the Queen’s permission in the 1570s. Then, he stole a lot of gold and treasure from the Spanish ships in the Caribbean. [C] He brought back a large amount of money to the Queen and, more importantly, held the entire trade across the globe. Surprisingly, in 1581, Queen Elizabeth knighted³ Francis Drake for his piracy because England had dominated the European trade and won against its rival, Spain.

The wealth brought by Francis Drake and his piracy was used to establish the East India Company of England. During the 17th, 18th and 19th centuries, the East India Company traded across many parts of the world, including Asia, South-East Asia and India. In 1613, it opened a trading post in Hirado, Japan, and it continued its business there until the beginning of Japan’s national isolation. [D] The British East India Company exported tea and cotton textiles⁴ from India and other Asian countries to Europe, earning huge profits. These profits increased Britain’s economic and military power, leading to the world’s first industrial revolution in the late 18th century.

The exciting but fictionalized⁵ image of ‘pirates’ you see, at present, in Disneyland, in movies and in manga is derived from⁶ people who attacked other ships and stole goods in the late 16th and early 17th century. Caribbean pirates were real people; not creations of fantasy. They have their own history. Today’s globalization and technological development partly, and dramatically, result from the dishonest and **destructive** conduct of pirates in the past.
