In stories and movies a cowboy is often a brave hero or a dangerous outlaw¹. But in the West, cowboys usually lived less heroic lives, for the most part taking care of cattle and doing small jobs.

Cowboys became a familiar sight out West after the Civil War². When the war ended, Americans in the East had a shortage of beef. Meanwhile, down in southern Texas, millions of beef cattle moved freely. Some businessmen decided to wild Texas cattle and sell them back East. But they faced one big problem: the railroad had not yet Texas. The cattle would have to walk to the nearest railroad station in Missouri, some fifteen hundred miles away! The was called the Long Drive, because cowboys would ride alongside the cattle herd³ and drive the cattle in the right direction.

Newspapers spread exaggerated reports about the money to be made in cattle ranching⁴. Soon many people rushed into the cattle business. Cattle ranching sprang up across the West, wherever there was enough grass for pasture⁵. With the of cattle ranching, the cowboy became a familiar sight on the Western frontier⁶.

Some people wrongly assume that developed countries are more advanced than developing countries in all aspects. However, others, especially those who have lived in or visited developing countries, sometimes report being positively affected by people in developing countries.

For example, a French American expressed his distinctive¹ opinion in this way. “I believe that French people, in general, think only about themselves, so I prefer people in developing countries to French people. [A] I went to Africa several times as a technological guide to teach Africans how to grow vegetables effectively, tackle² food shortages, and cut trees legally to prevent illegal deforestation³. The Africans responded not only by expressing their **gratitude** but also by sharing their scarce food with me. Their generous spirit touched me deeply.” A group of British people who visited Africa for sightseeing also mentioned the African spirit of sharing. “African people rarely enjoy material prosperity but still lead happy lives by sharing what they have with their neighbors. That attitude was really impressive to us.”

Although the travelers above differ in nationality and purpose when visiting Africa, they had one thing in common: they were impressed with the African spirit of sharing. [B] Alfred Adler, a famous Austrian psychologist, pointed out that true happiness has much to do with the conduct 50. He is said to have advised patients suffering from depression⁴: “You can be healed of depression if you begin, each morning, to consider how you will bring real joy to someone else.” Whether or not people have this spirit of sharing seems to be closely related to the fact that while developed nations have many patients suffering from depression, developing countries have few cases of patients suffering from depression. [C]

Also, an American traveler mentioned: “Americans have mainly pursued material prosperity up to now, but we have to revise this attitude. I lived in a developing country as a child because of my father’s work. I was amazed by the fact that the people there looked happy with a minimum amount of material comfort. [D] After I returned to the United States, I first thought about recycling the plastic bottles I had collected on beaches. I now ask companies or NPOs to take the cell phones I have picked up and remove the important metals. Many metal parts from old cell phones can be recycled.”

The present benchmarks⁵ of classifying nations into developed and developing nations are employed only in terms of economy and technology. This categorization⁶ is questionable if we take into account happiness and coexistence with nature.
