Today, we use remote controls for all kinds of things: turning lights on and off, playing music, opening and closing garage¹ doors—41 controlling pet dogs. But the remote control we use most often turns our TV on and off, changes channels, and controls the volume. But do you know which came first, the TV or the TV remote control?

The first real television made its debut in October 1925. That's when Scottish inventor John Logie Baird showed an image of a ventriloquist's puppet² named Stooky Bill. That same year, Japanese inventor Kenjiro Takayanagi introduced a simple television system at Hamamatsu Technical High School³. And in 1927, an American named Philo Farnsworth demonstrated his own 42 TV system.

But what about the remote control? Actually, the first remote control came nearly 30 years

43 the invention of the TV. It was created in 1898 by the Serbian⁴ inventor Nikola Tesla, who wanted to control

44 from far away. He came up with the idea for what he called "teleautomation." He first used his invention to remote control a small boat, demonstrating it publicly at an exhibition in New York. His invention amazed the public, who had never seen anything like it before.

It was not 45 1956 that the first modern TV remote control appeared. The president of Zenith, a TV manufacturer, did not like watching TV commercials. One of his company's engineers, Robert Adler, designed a remote control that could change the channels. This meant that his "boss" did not have to sit through commercials, and he did not have to get up off his sofa to change channels, either.

Japan is famous for its advanced technology and engineering. One example of this is its undersea tunnels. [A] These tunnels connect different parts of Japan, making it easy for both people and goods to move between the islands. They play an important role in keeping transportation smooth across the country. Let's look at two of Japan's most well-known undersea tunnels: the Seikan Tunnel and the Kanmon Tunnel.

The Seikan Tunnel is the longest undersea tunnel in the world, stretching 53.85 kilometers, with 23.3 kilometers running directly under the Tsugaru Strait¹. It connects Honshu to Hokkaido. This tunnel was completed in 1988 after over 20 years of construction. [B] One main reason for building it was the dangerous sea conditions between Honshu and Hokkaido. The rough waters during storms caused many terrible accidents, with ships sinking in the strait.

The Seikan Tunnel is used by both passenger trains and freight trains². Bullet trains³ also pass through the tunnel as part of the Hokkaido Shinkansen Line. This makes travel between Honshu and Hokkaido much faster and more convenient. However, building the Seikan Tunnel was extremely difficult. Engineers had to dig through very hard rock deep under the sea and deal with the risk of water leaks⁴. These challenges make the tunnel one of Japan's greatest engineering achievements.

Another famous undersea tunnel is the Kanmon Tunnel, which runs under the Kanmon Strait, connecting Honshu to Kyushu, Japan's third-largest island. The Kanmon Tunnel is 49 the Seikan Tunnel, only 3.6 kilometers long. It opened in 1958 and had both road and railway tunnels, which made it useful for both drivers and train passengers.

A special feature of the Kanmon Tunnel is that it has a walkway for pedestrians⁵. This means that people can actually walk under the sea to cross between Honshu and Kyushu. [C] The walkway is about one kilometer long, and there are signs inside the tunnel that show the exact border between the two islands. Many tourists enjoy the rare experience of walking under the sea, which makes this tunnel even more interesting.

Japan's geography creates many challenges for transportation. The country is full of mountains, and it is made up of many islands, which makes building roads, railways, and bridges very difficult. [D] These tunnels are especially important for moving goods and connecting faraway areas.

Undersea tunnels are also very important during natural disasters. When typhoons or earthquakes make sea or air travel impossible, undersea tunnels allow transportation to continue safely. This makes them an important part of the <u>infrastructure</u> in Japan.

Japan's undersea tunnels are great examples of engineering that help solve the country's transportation problems. From the famous Seikan Tunnel to the unique Kanmon Tunnel, these tunnels make travel easier and safer, and show Japan's commitment to using technology and innovation to solve problems.
