English has been recognized as an important language for international and intercultural<sup>1</sup> communication in Asia, and of course all over the world. But the important thing about the current state of English is that there is no "one" English: there are many varieties of English. We have to understand these characteristics of contemporary English if we wish to learn and use it as a language for wider communication across the world.

Contemporary English has two 41 tendencies: (1) its global spread, and (2) the development of a vast number of national varieties. You can call (1) as the internationalization of English and (2) as the diversification<sup>2</sup> of English. People often find it difficult to comprehend the diversification part, but the diversification of English is the natural outcome of the internationalization of the English language. We cannot have one without the other. They are two sides of the same coin.

The global spread of English is observed 42 the world. In addition to the countries where English is a native tongue of many of their citizens, there are more countries where it functions<sup>3</sup> as a second, or an official language. Furthermore, there are many other countries where English is 43, learned, and used as an international language.

In fact, English is now used all over the world as an intermediary language<sup>4</sup> of wider communication on a regional as well as global basis. Under these circumstances, it is important that we should be 44 of the fact that there are far more non-native speakers than native speakers when it comes to English. There is no other language 45 English in this respect. English is such a unique language.

After the cherry blossom season, many Japanese look forward to seeing wisteria<sup>1</sup> flowers blooming in gardens, parks, and mountains. Wisteria is a member of the pea family<sup>2</sup>, found in Japan on Honshu and further south. The flowers are pale purple, white, or pink, with large clusters of flowers hanging downwards.

In Japan, wisteria flowers have long been loved for their elegance and the way they sway in the wind. [ A ] *Manyoshu*, Japan's oldest poetry collection, contains poems about wisteria flowers. *The Tale of Genji*, too, has characters associated with wisteria, such as Fujitsubo and Murasaki no Ue. "Fuji," written in kanji, means wisteria, and "murasaki" means purple. *The Tale of Genji* is a love story set at the Japanese Imperial Court. It was written over a thousand years ago by Murasaki Shikibu.

The main character, Hikaru Genji, falls in love with Fujitsubo, who closely <u>resembles</u> his mother and is quite beautiful, although she is the legal wife of the emperor. Genji suffers from his love for her but never forgets her throughout his life. [B] He finds Murasaki no Ue, with whom he spends the rest of his life, but he falls in love with other women many times. The name Murasaki no Ue suggests a connection with Fujitsubo. Wisteria and purple are associated with beautiful things in the story. [C]

It must be pointed out that Fujiwara no Michinaga was in power in the Heian period. Michinaga's daughter was married to the emperor and lived in a mansion called "Fujitsubo."

To 50 his daughter, Michinaga had Murasaki Shikibu serve her. Some experts say he ordered Murasaki Shikibu to write interesting stories during this time, which resulted in *The Tale of Genji*. The Fujiwara clan<sup>3</sup> held great power then, so several families used wisteria as the crest<sup>4</sup> for their family name.

Kasuga Taisha Shrine in Nara is also famous for wisteria. There have been wisteria trees in the shrine since time immemorial<sup>5</sup>. [D] The shrine uses wisteria as the crest because it is closely related to the Fujiwara family. The wisteria motif is on lanterns, crowns used in a religious festival, and ornamental hairpins<sup>6</sup> of shrine maidens<sup>7</sup>.

Recently, several parks, such as Ashikaga Flower Park, have created large wisteria tunnels made of vines, attracting many tourists. The sight of the wisteria flowers lit up at night is magical! Their spectacular appearance fascinates viewers and makes them stop in their tracks. In the popular manga *Demon Slayer* (*Kimetsu no Yaiba*), wisteria is described as a flower with an extraordinary power that even demons cannot approach. For Japanese people, wisteria is a familiar flower, like cherry blossoms, both now and in the past.
