

#### Color and Cost

The co	plor of food is of great importance to people. If a plate contains different kinds of foods with
38	colors, it does not appear as delicious as one with a mixture of foods with bright colors.

Although most kinds of foods have one color (e.g. milk is white, strawberries are red, broccoli is green, etc.), many types have two. The bread, rice, eggs and sugar sitting on supermarket shelves are 39 white or brown.

It is not easy to find one type of food that comes in three different colors. However, a vegetable called the bell pepper has three different colors: green, yellow and red. Have you ever wondered why consumers have a 40 of such colors? To find out, the place to look is the peppers' price label. You will see that green peppers are the cheapest and red peppers are the most expensive.

So what is the reason for the difference in price? Green peppers are picked 41 they mature so they taste slightly bitter but contain vitamins A and C. As for yellow peppers, they are picked when they are semi-ripe and contain more nutrients<sup>1</sup> than green peppers but not as many as the red variety. For instance, they have almost twice as much vitamin C as their less mature versions. Red peppers, however, contain the highest amount of nutrients. They also taste sweet since they are fully matured when picked although the longer growth time 42 in higher prices than the other two colors.

So like tree leaves changing color in the fall, green bell peppers mature into a yellow color and then turn red. For consumers, these peppers picked at 43 stages of growth allow them to enjoy their different flavors and benefits for health.

The first time I lived abroad was as an exchange student in Germany. One day, the children in my host family and I were planning a surprise birthday party for their mother. They asked me how old my mother was. I responded that in the US, women are forever 21. While we enjoy celebrating birthdays each year, we never get any older once we celebrate our 21st birthday.

The next day my host mother got a call from the children's teacher. The teacher had heard what I had said and couldn't understand why I had told such a lie. Of course I apologized for the misunderstanding, and that evening, my host mother and I explained to the children that women in the US <u>age</u> just the same as everyone else, even if they don't like to admit it.

In fact, it is considered rude in the US to ask a woman her age. [ A ] You can even see birthday supplies in abundance for things such as "the tenth anniversary of your 20th birthday." That may seem strange to a Japanese person who daily sees people's ages announced in the newspaper or on TV, regardless of whether they are male or female.

One of my Japanese colleagues had a birthday and I wanted to make the day special for him. I got a cake and asked the faculty to sing in a loud voice when I came into the room with his birthday cake aglow<sup>1</sup> with burning candles. But instead of a happy smile, he looked at me with a very surprised expression. I began to wonder if I had the date wrong! [B] And then, when I put the cake in front of him, he said "Honto ni sumimasen."

The next time another Japanese colleague had a birthday, I was careful not to repeat the same mistake. I went shopping for a nice gift but then gave it to her privately so as not to embarrass her. I was shocked when the first thing she said was exactly the same as my other colleague. Why was she apologizing for receiving a birthday present?

I asked a good Japanese friend of mine to explain what I was doing wrong. She said: "Both times, your colleagues were very pleased with your gift. But they were worried about causing you inconvenience. You spent time shopping for them, bringing their gifts to the office and you really didn't have to do that. [ C ] I think you really did make them very happy."

Of course, I was quite relieved to hear this explanation. It made me realize how I had been acting in a very goal oriented way which is typical for Americans. My goal was to make my friends happy on their birthday and that's what I tried to communicate with my words and actions. [ D ] But to my friends, who are Japanese, they were concerned that in the 49 of celebrating their birthdays, I had been inconvenienced on their behalf and felt the need to apologize.
