I'm here at the popular Hollywood Walk of Fame in Los Angeles. I can see a lot of stars on the ground. Do you know how popular Hollywood Walk of Fame is? Well, it receives 10,000,000 every year. OK, so, where is it? Who do the stars honor? How many stars are there? What's the length of the Walk? How much does it cost? The center of the Walk is at the corner of Hollywood Boulevard and Vine Street¹. Over 2,500 stars along 18 blocks honor individuals from the entertainment business. It's free! Today, there are cosplayers of a beautiful princess, a popular superhero and a hairy guy from another planet!

Hollywood is the of the movies in the world, and home to the Academy Awards, or the Oscars. The golden statuettes² which are presented to the actors as trophies are also called Oscars. When the Oscars began in 1929, 270 people gathered here, at the Hollywood Roosevelt Hotel. The Chinese Theatre the Oscars in 1944, 1945 and 1946. Before you enter the theater, you can see handprints and footprints of famous . If you're lucky, you'll also see popular cartoon characters, or maybe even real movie stars. Today, the Oscars take place here, in the Dolby Theatre, next to the Chinese Theatre.

Los Angeles is also known for its many great festivals throughout the year. The Golden Dragon Parade is held in February to celebrate The Chinese New Year. I recommend the Holi Festival of Colors. People are sprayed with colorful powder. This is a Hindi of welcoming spring. Caribbean Heritage Month is in June with the Hollywood Carnival. Traditional Japanese dance and music are performed in Little Tokyo at the Nisei Week Festival in August. And colorful make-up of bones of the head is worn by people of Mexican ancestry³ at the Day of the Dead Festival in October.

Research shows that executives spend almost 23 hours a week in meetings on average, and most regular employees also have two or three meetings every week. With the rise in remote working¹ during the coronavirus pandemic², you might have thought that the number of meetings would decline. Analysis by experts showed that although meetings were on average 12 percent shorter than before the pandemic, people were attending 13 percent more of them.

What are the advantages of spending so much of our working day discussing things with colleagues? Steven Rogelberg, a business professor, says that meetings are a fundamental part of human nature. By discussing problems together, we can reach creative solutions that might not be possible for individuals working alone. [A] For members of a team working on a project, meetings can be a way to share information, brainstorm ideas³, and clarify⁴ goals. It's harder to avoid doing your work or taking responsibility when you know you have to give regular face-to-face progress reports.

Meetings do, however, come with significant disadvantages. The biggest disadvantage is the time they consume. It is not only the meeting itself that takes time, but also the need to prepare for it beforehand and reflect on it afterwards. The physical and mental energy of participants is also wasted, leading to reduced productivity. [B] A survey reported that 34 percent of employees feel they waste up to five hours per week on meaningless gatherings.

Would having no meetings at all improve the productivity of a company? There are companies that have banned meetings altogether, believing them to be a waste of their employees' time. [C] TheSoul Publishing is one of them. A global company with over 2,000 employees, it produces content for YouTube, TikTok and other social media sites, creating more than 1,500 videos each month. Its workers, 80 percent of whom work remotely, are banned from holding meetings, either in-person or online.

But a no-meetings policy doesn't work everywhere. Companies like TheSoul Publishing were founded with the rule already established. It is much harder to ban meetings in an environment where they are common. [D] Professor Rogelberg knows companies that have tried introducing particular days where meetings are not permitted, but the result has been a sharp increase in emails going back and forth among workers.

Rogelberg recommends reform instead of completely banning meetings. "The goal isn't to eliminate meetings, it's to eliminate the bad ones." He suggests limiting the size and length of meetings to force participants to 48 quickly. He also thinks managers should receive training to learn how to conduct a meeting successfully. "You need to make them effective," he concludes.
